

## Cloudy Sticker – Why Do My Stickers Have a Cloudy Appearance?

On clear Add-On Stickers, what you are seeing is the adhesive backing that shows through clear material. After putting the stickers on the keyboard, this cloudy look disappears as pressure is applied to the sticker surface. It generally goes away in a few days, if not immediately. If your stickers are printed with white ink, this effect may be especially noticeable since the adhesive is cloudy-white in color. It may be especially difficult to distinguish the white printing from the cloudy adhesive.

If you have already tried putting a couple of stickers on your keyboard and the problem persists and you are not satisfied with the look of the stickers after application to the keyboard, another set of clear stickers will be subject to the same condition.

There is another approach to this. A solid color set of Bilingual Stickers is one sure way of not seeing the adhesive.

Our printing on the sticker material is done with vector-based graphics at 2400 dpi. If you feel the printing quality is the issue, it is doubtful that another set will be any different.
